

BILATERAL TRADE

INTRODUCTION

Trade between India and Thailand has picked up significantly since 1998. With a Framework Agreement for establishing a Free Trade Area (FTA) between the two countries in place since October 2003, in which the Early Harvest Scheme (EHS) comprising 82 items (at 6-digit level) became operational from 1.9.2004 and has since been reduced to zero duty from 1.9.2006, bilateral trade is expected to pick up significantly in the years ahead.

OVERVIEW

Trade between the two countries grew significantly during 1997 and 2002 from US\$ 569 million in 1997-98 to US\$ 1056 million in 2001-02. In 2002-03, the total trade grew 3% to US\$ 1090 million, and would have remained/peaked at this level had it not been for the Early Harvest Scheme under Framework Agreement signed on 9.10.1993. India-Thailand Bilateral Trade Statistics for the years 1997-98 to 2006-07 are given in **Table-I** below

INDIA'S EXPORTS TO THAILAND

The major items of India's exports to Thailand are:

- a. Precious stones, diamonds and jewellery
- b. Copper & articles thereof
- c. Iron & Steel and products
- d. Oil-meal, Oil-cake (Animal feed)
- e. Chemicals (mainly organic)
- f. Metal ores, waste and scrap
- g. Parts & accessories of vehicles
- h. Industrial machinery
- i. Electrical machinery and parts
- j. Medicinal & Pharmaceutical products

k. Cotton

Diamonds for jewellery have been traditionally India's most important export item. Exports of computer parts and accessories, industrial use machines and iron and steel from India registered a significant increase in 2002 and 2003. During the years 2004 and 2005 diamonds/gemstones, copper and articles thereof, chemicals iron & steel animal feeders, etc were main items of Indian exports to Thailand. India's exports to Thailand at 2-digit HS level during 2005-06 and 2006-07 (Apr-Sep) are given in **Table – II** below.

INDIA'S IMPORT FROM THAILAND:

The major items of India's imports from Thailand are:

- a. Polymers of Ethylene, propylene in primary forms
- b. Motor car parts and accessories
- c. Iron & Steel products
- d. Automatic data processing machines & parts thereof
- e. Television and radio broadcast equipment
- f. Spark ignition internal combustion piston engine and parts thereof
- g. Rubber
- h. Essential oils and cosmetics
- i. Organic Chemicals
- j. Precious stones, diamonds and jewellery
- k. Industrial Machinery and parts
- l. Man-made filaments and staple fibres

Traditionally, agricultural commodities and agro-related commodities have been the major components of Thai exports to India. Thai exports of automatic data processing machines, motorcar parts and accessories and rubber witnessed noteworthy increases in 2002 and 2003. In 2004 and 2005, exports of polymers of ethylene, propylene, etc. in primary forms; electrical machinery; iron & steel and articles thereof; motorcar parts and accessories; chemicals; television equipment etc. have acquired greater importance. Thailand's exports to India at 2-digit HS level during 2005-06 and 2006-07 (Apr-Sep) are given in **Table - III** below: -
